

Behavior Contract Application

By definition, GRACE is a home school workshop and requires a parent for each family to be in the building while his or her children are in classes. Behavior contracts allow students to be at GRACE under the supervision of another adult member of GRACE. They are privileges and reviewed each year by the board.

Criteria for a behavior contract-

The applying family must have attended GRACE for a minimum of 1 year and be in good standing. The applying family must secure a supervising family who has also been attending GRACE for a minimum of 1 year and is also in good standing. We prefer to limit behavior contract to student 16 and over but will review each request on a case by case basis.
